AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in all jump heights in all classes and categories (except Chances, which is Pass/Fail). Purple qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying run.

Please let us know in advance if you may receive a special award so we may celebrate the moment with you.

CLASS CHANGES

If you wish to move your dog up to a higher class prior to the trial, you must notify the trial secretary no later than midnight January 23, 2012. Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday **Move-ups** OK if made within 30 minutes of the conclusion of runs on Friday and Saturday.

FRIDAY AFTERNOON SET-UP

Ring set up will start at NOON. Individual set ups can immediately follow completion of the ring/club set ups. So toss your stuff down to claim an area, then please pitch in and give us a hand! You will receive Bowser Bucks for helping with setup!

CHECK-IN AND MEASUREMENT

Check in and measuring between 1:15 and 1:45 pm AFTER GENERAL SETUP on Friday afternoon (please come help if you are available); 7:00 – 7:30 am on Saturday/Sunday. General Judge's Briefing at 1:45pm on Friday; 7:40am on Sat/Sun. First Dog on the Line at 2:00 PM Friday; 8 AM Sat/Sun.

Measurement forms may be obtained at <http://nadac.com/ApplicationforPermanentHeightCard.htm>. Dogs which require measuring: Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16". Dogs which do not need to be measured: Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division, Dogs jumping 20" and 20+, Dogs in the Skilled Category, Dogs with a permanent height card, Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List.

Jump Heights: There are five Standard Division Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", 20", 20+. There are four Standard Division Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16". There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16". Please see the NADAC Rulebook for the full jump height table.

FOOD

Breakfast items will be available on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Lunch will be provided on Saturday and Sunday for workers of more than two classes. Drinks will be available for volunteers on all three days.

EQUIPMENT

UDAC uses **rubber skins** on the contact equipment, **electronic** timers with automatic eyes, and jumps with a single bar.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

Friday: Numbered Hoopers, Tunnelers, Weavers; small to tall

Saturday: Chances, Jumpers, Regular 1, Regular 2, Numbered Hoopers, Touch N'Go; tall to small

Sunday: Jumpers, Chances, Regular 3, Regular 4, Tunnelers, Weavers; tall to small

Each class will run Elite, Open, Novice (EON) except for the back to back Regular classes with will run EEOONN.

RINGS

This is a one judge / two ring trial, where we will be going back and forth between the two rings. Ring 1, used for most games classes (in the small field), will have chain-link fencing on two sides, and surveyor's tape held up by 3 foot stakes on the other two sides. Ring 2 will have snow fencing on all four sides.

Proficient/Skilled Categories:

Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled. **Note:** When entering the Skilled Category, all dogs must jump 4" lower than their Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. You must indicate whether you are entering the Skilled or Proficient Category for the entire weekend.

Non-Jumping Classes – Veteran Handler:

Disabled handlers or handlers aged 60 yrs. or older may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive additional standard course time. **This division is for handlers only.** The additional SCT is for qualifying purposes only for those who may need the additional time to negotiate the course due to physical limitations. Veteran Handlers in the non-jumping classes will be scored and placed with their standard division jump height. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all classes and all dogs in this division for the weekend.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE:

Lake Wohlford Canine Ranch, 26417 North Lake Wohlford Rd, Valley Center, CA 92082

From I-15 Southbound:

Exit on Centre City Pkwy. Turn left at West El Norte Pkwy. Turn left at East Valley Pkwy. Turn right at Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd, turn into dirt driveway.

From I-15 Northbound:

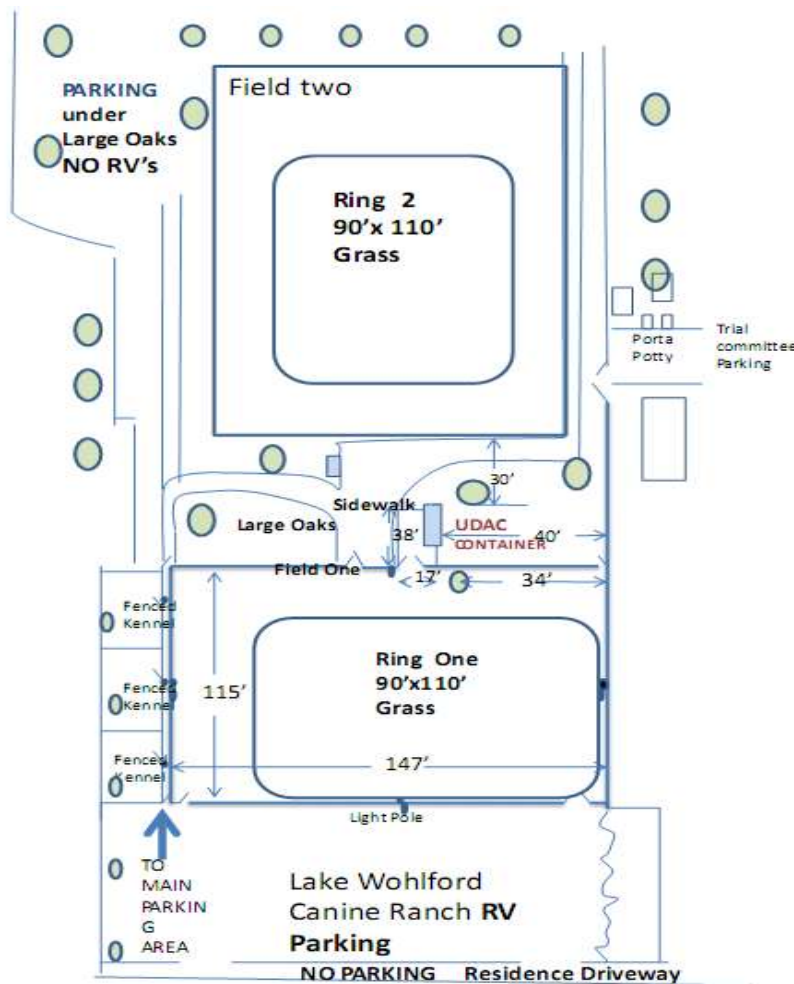
Exit on Via Rancho Pkwy, which becomes Bear Valley Pkwy, continuing until it ends at East Valley Pkwy. Turn right onto East Valley Pkwy. Turn right at Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd, turn into dirt driveway.

From CA-78 East:

CA-78 becomes E. Lincoln. Continue on E. Lincoln Ave. Turn right on El Norte Pkwy, continuing to East Valley Pkwy. Turn left on East Valley Pkwy. Turn right at Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd, turn into dirt driveway.

Alternate directions for RVers (avoids the tight right hand turn into the driveway):

From East Valley Pkwy all approaches, continue on East Valley Parkway past Lake Wohlford Road, turn right on Woods Valley Road, turn right at North Lake Wohlford Road and continue for approximately 0.7 miles. Turn left at 26417 North Wohlford Road into the dirt driveway.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs. Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC or Ups N Downs Agility Club will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- ****Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.**

- A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com . Exhibitors may request a printed copy of the current Exhibitor Handbook by sending \$5.00 to: *North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC) P.O. Box 1206, Colbert, OK 74733*
- This trial is open to any dog at least eighteen months of age, including purebred and non-purebred.
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health, and welfare of the dog.
- There shall be no refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the organizing committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no fees shall be refunded.
- **All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring**, and must be contained unless being prepared to run.
- A withdrawal from the trial after closing date due to an injury and/or illness to the dog will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. A veterinarian's notice of injury or illness will be required for a refund. Bitches which come in season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) and their crating area.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

AGREEMENT. The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairs, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including NADAC officers directors, employees and members), Ups N Downs Agility Club (including Ups N Downs Agility Club officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), **and the owner or lessor of the premises** and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
